BroilerNet aims to enhance the resilience and sustainability of the European broiler sector by creating space for interaction between science and practice and co-creation of ready-to-use innovative best practices on broiler farms in Europe. Partners from 13 countries are involved, both the broiler sector and research organisations, and the project is running four years.

BroilerNet are creating Broiler Innovation Networks (BINs) of broiler farmers, advisors, integrators, farmers' organisations, researchers and veterinarians on national and international level. These BINs will address the upcoming challenges faced by broiler farmers, and collect and evaluate good practices around the **three key themes:** environmental sustainability, animal welfare and animal health.
